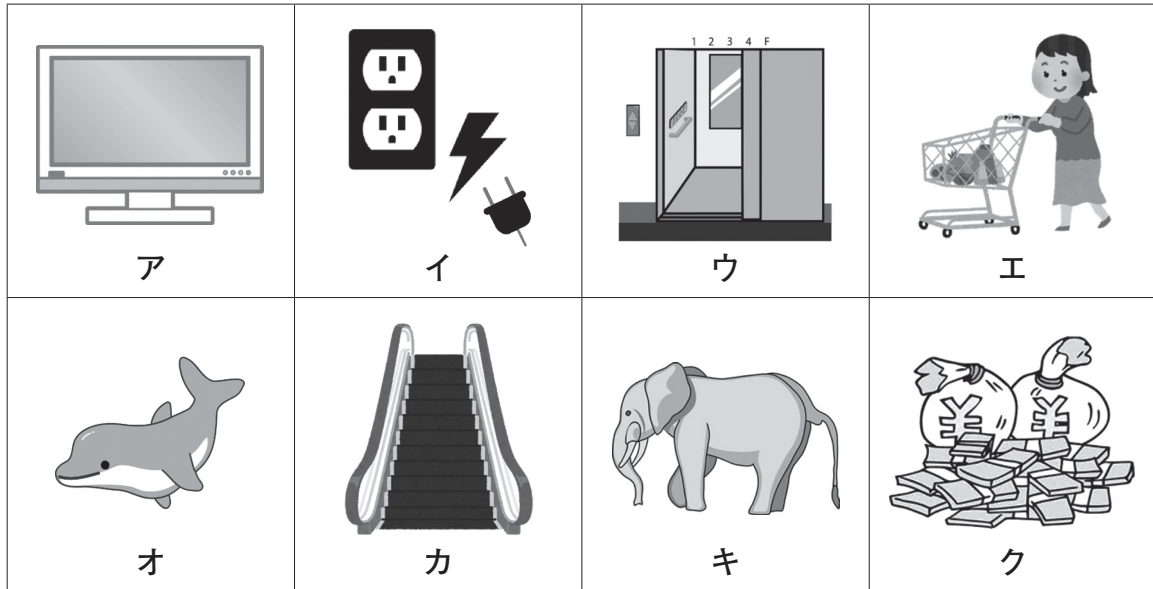

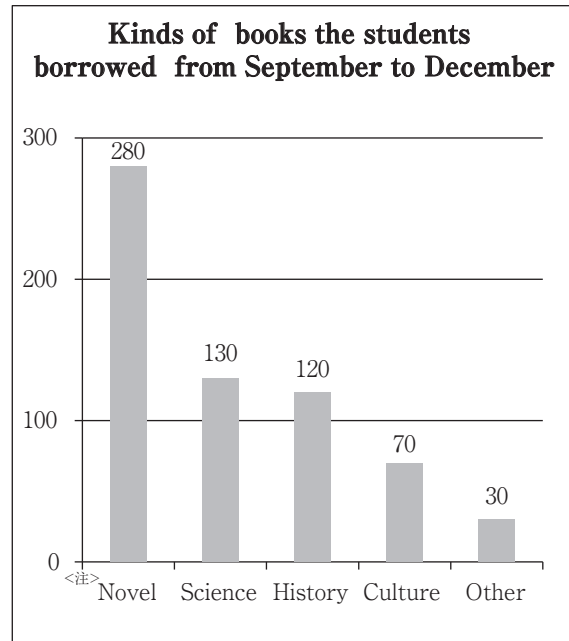
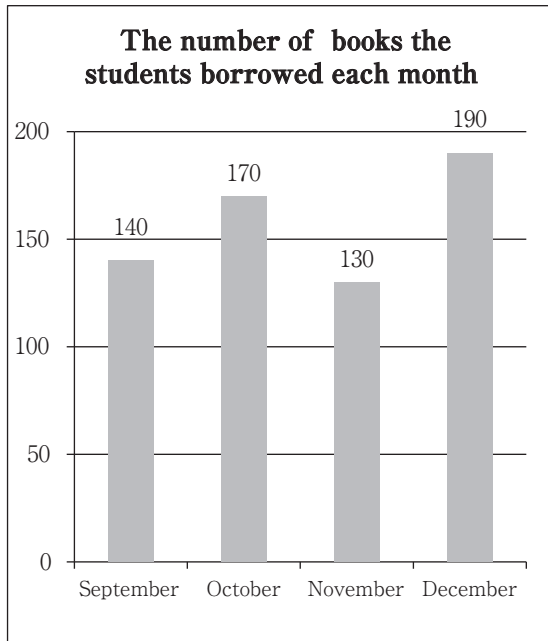

【第3問題】 次の文章は、アメリア・イアハート（Amelia Earhart）という人物についてのものである。これを読んで後の問1～問3に答えなさい。

Eighty-one years ago Amelia Earhart disappeared during the last ^{<注1>}flight around the world. Many years have passed since her last radio call on July 2, 1937. Why did she disappear? The answer is still a mystery. But many people have wondered for a long time. After she disappeared, the United States government had the largest ever search for a lost aircraft, but nothing was found. Today the search still continues.

Many pilots disappeared without a ^{<注2>}trace at that time, but Earhart's case was never forgotten. One of the reason is that she was a famous person during her life.

Earhart started her airplane career in 1928. She was shown a ^{<注3>}suggestion by a ^{<注4>}publisher George Palmer Putnam. He asked her, "Do you want to be the first woman to fly across ^{<注5>}the Atlantic Ocean, Earhart?" Then she said "Yes." But later she wrote that she was just a ^{<注6>}passenger on the trip, and not actually flying the plane. In 1932, she got her chance in the pilot's seat to fly across the Atlantic.

She became the first woman that ^{<注7>}crossed the Atlantic. Dorothy Cochrane is the leader of the ^{<注8>}Smithsonian National Air and Space Museum, and he said, "She had a lot of ^{<注9>}courage. And women didn't have many chances at that time, but she tried to be different." He also said, "She did a lot in a man's world, and made her own career and used this success and hard work to encourage others."

Earhart traveled around the country, and spoke to schools. At events about airplanes, she encouraged young people to follow their dreams. She was really a star all over the world, but one day she disappeared.

Some people wondered she was caught by the Japanese. And other people thought she did not want to be a (A) celebrity. But the U.S. government thought that she used all the gas she had on the airplane and ^{<注10>}crashed into the sea near Howland Island in the Pacific Ocean. The International Group for Historic Aircraft Recovery (TIGHAR) have been searching for her last place. TIGHAR believes they are sure that she died as a (B) castaway on a lonely Pacific island. The dogs to find bones are also used on the island. But nothing is not still found.

Earhart was just a woman. She just flew an airplane. So, why do we want to know what happened to her? Because she showed generations that we can do anything, Cochrane said.

Mr.Hino: You're right. Studying abroad is one of the best way to learn foreign languages.

Seyeon: It's true. Kazuki, if you want to improve your English, I think you should go abroad.

Kazuki: I think that's a good idea. My dream is to study ^{<注3>}space engineering in America and I want to work at ^{<注4>}NASA the future.

Mr.Hino: Wow! In America, you can also learn about cultures.

Seyeon: You can also make new friends in America ^{<注5>}as I did in Japan.

Mr.Hino: Studying abroad will be an exciting experience many ways. There are many things (**2 learn**) in other countries.

Kazuki: Do you have any other trouble, Seyeon?

Seyeon: I got ^{<注6>}homesick. I studied Japanese hard before coming to Japan, but I didn't understand the things my host family and Japanese students said when I came to Japan. I didn't try to speak to my host family and other students in Japanese. I ^{<注7>}missed my family and friends in Korea, so I sent e-mails to them in my room every day.

Mr.Hino: Oh, I feel so sorry for you.

Kazuki: You had a difficult time when you came to Japan.

Seyeon: Don't worry because I know I was wrong. Everyone tried to be kind to me. One day, one of my friends (**3 invite**) me to a ^{<注8>}barbecue party. I didn't want to go and told that to my mother by e-mail. She said that I should go and try to change myself, so I decided to go to the party. At the party, we tried hard to communicate with each other with body language and ^{<注9>}poor Japanese. We
