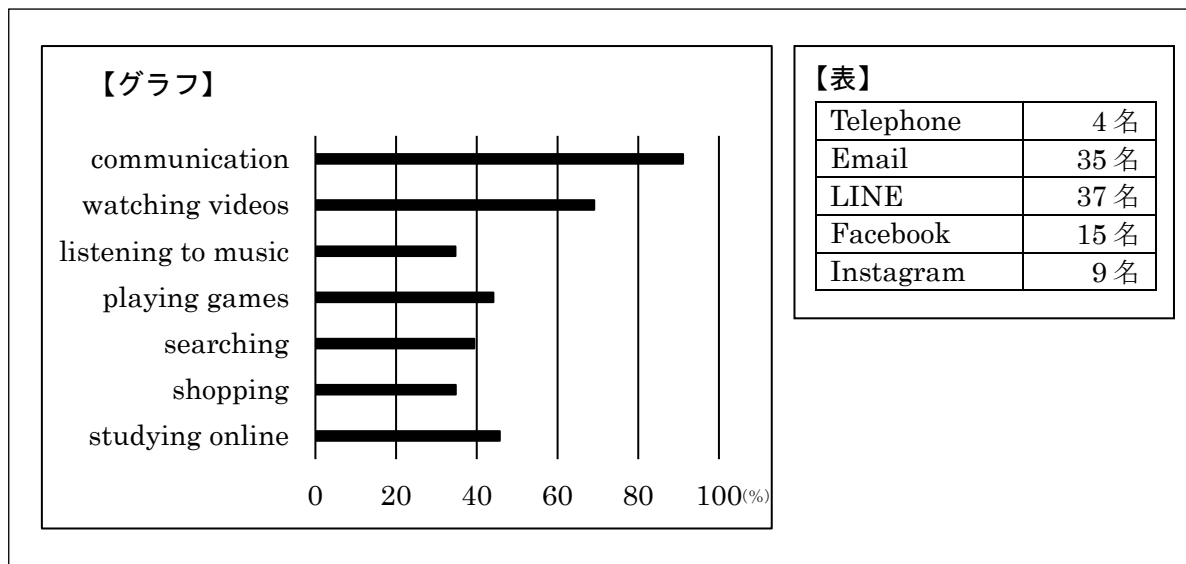

One day at noon, a man called Robert Johnson ate a lot of tomatoes in front of many people. People who watched him were cried out, but they said, "We were wrong." After that, in the nineteenth century, tomatoes were often sold in America.

Do you have enough time to sleep every day? What time did you go to bed last night? I have heard that people sleep for *one-third of their lives, but we can't live without sleeping. Sleeping well is important for staying healthy and *organizing our *thoughts and things we learned. Today, I'm going to talk about the importance of sleep.

You may say, "I sleep for 7 hours a day, so A." But according to some scientists, the *average sleeping hours of Japanese people is shorter than that of people in many other countries. People in America and India sleep about an hour longer than we do. In addition, they say that sleeping hours of Japanese people is getting shorter than before. Even when you sleep for 7 hours, you sometimes feel tired or sleepy, right? So, you can't say that you have slept enough. If people don't sleep enough, they will have many problems. For example, they may feel more nervous or get angry more easily. They may also get sick more often. On the other hand, if they get enough sleep, they can keep their body and mind healthy. Sleeping well every day is necessary to live and help people grow. Also, ⁽¹⁾it *prevents people from getting older sooner.

Some scientists say that students in Japan sleep for shorter hours than students in other countries because they *stay up late at night. Some students may study or watch TV until late at night. Others may communicate with their friends by using their smartphones. Today, more and more people have their own smartphones and can *contact others easily by using them. Of course, smartphones are very useful because they can *access the internet easily to get information when they want. Also, they can enjoy playing games online until late at night. But the light that smartphones *emit is bad for our eyes, and it takes long time to fall asleep. For these reasons, sleeping hours of students in Japan become shorter.

There are ⁽²⁾three important things to sleep well. First, getting some exercise during the day is good. By doing so, you will feel a little tired and sleepy *naturally. Second, you shouldn't eat too much before sleeping. Some doctors say that it is good to finish eating dinner three hours before going to bed. Third, don't use *digital devices like smartphones, tablet PCs, or computers before going to bed. So, I have made a rule. I don't use my smartphone or tablet PC after 9 p.m. I think that sleeping well every day will keep me healthy. I also think I will be able to study harder and enjoy many activities during the day.

We should be more careful about our *lifestyles. ⁽³⁾Do you have any good ideas to make our lives better?
